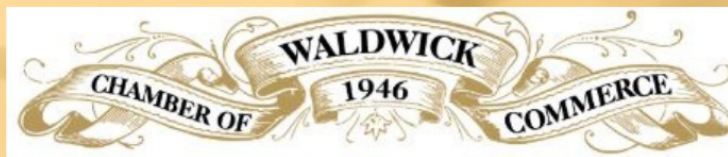

Here is some follow-up information from December's NJ Chamber Meeting:

### NJ Chamber Alliance Zoom Meeting

December 2, 2022

#### Federal Update

- U.S. House and Senate approved legislation ending a looming rail strike. Biden is expected to sign it.
- The House will flip to Republican majority. Kevin McCarthy will probably be new speaker.
- McCarthy will have uphill battle because the GOP majority is slim.
- Spending bill has to be signed by Dec. 16.

#### State Update

- The Assembly has put together some pro-business bills, including one that addresses delays in the state's real estate inspections.
- There is a bill introduced to cut the CBT that has little chance.
- We continue to have meetings with legislative leaders and it's starting to have some impact.
- We encourage all of you and your members to continue to reach out to legislators and ask for pro-business legislation.
